



MOTORCOACH INFORMATION

Parking and traffic regulations can be viewed on the City of San Francisco's Website at www.sfgov.org. Click on "Most Requested" then click on "Municipal Codes" and then click on "San Francisco Municipal Codes Index." Click on "San Francisco Transportation Code." Relevant sections include Article 500. LOADING AND UNLOADING AREAS

The following are officially designated tour bus loading and unloading areas. In addition, white zones (passenger loading only) are available outside most hotels and major attractions.

- **Chinatown** Bus loading is available on the east side of Columbus Avenue just north of Washington Street. Ten-minute time limit.
- **Fisherman's Wharf Area** (for updates – www.visitfishermanswharf.com). Coaches should unload guests at any of the areas listed below in addition to the Pier 39 turn-out. When using location on the Little Embarcadero location, departing buses have two choices: they can turn left on to Taylor Street (congested) or continue straight on to Pier 45 and make a U-turn in the road between Fisherman's Grotto #9 Restaurant and the trash compactor area. Large buses will need to do a small three-point turn but then they can leave the Fisherman's Wharf area eastbound on The Embarcadero and south on Powell Street.

- **Alcatraz** Alcatraz Cruises is located at Pier 33 (Alcatraz Landing) on The Embarcadero. Motorcoaches are allowed to off-load and pick up passengers at Pier 33. Motorcoach parking is not available at the pier or on the street in front of the pier, but is available at other Fisherman's Wharf locations. Note that the City of San Francisco has plans in 2011 to develop street parking in the area to serve cruise ship passengers. When cruise ships are not docking, motorcoaches may use those spaces for loading and unloading.
- **Civic Center Area** Loading is available on the north side of Fulton Street between Hyde and Larkin Streets adjacent to the Asian Art Museum, near City Hall, War Memorial Opera House, Davies Symphony Hall and other cultural attractions. Fifteen-minute time limit.
- **PIER 39** The loading zone directly in front of PIER 39 can only be approached from westbound on The Embarcadero. If traveling east (i.e. Beach Street), turn right on Taylor or Powell Street, left on North Point Street, then left onto The Embarcadero. Do not park in the red zone on The Embarcadero.
- **Golden Gate National Recreation Area** See specific information below for Alcatraz, Crissy Field, Point Lobos-Cliff House-Sutro Baths, and Fort Mason as well as information on Commercial Use Authorization (below).
- **Golden Gate Park/Conservatory of Flowers** The north side of John F. Kennedy Drive west of the Conservatory. M-Sa only.
- **Mission Dolores** On the west side of Dolores Street in front of the Mission. Twenty-minute time limit.

- **St. Mary's Cathedral** On the south side of Geary Expressway west of Gough Street and on the west side of Gough Street south of Geary. Off-limits on Sundays during services. No overnight parking.
- **Union Square** North side of Geary Street between Grant Avenue and Stockton Street. Ten-minute time limit available M–F 11am–4pm, 6–8pm; Sa–Su 11am–8pm. North side of Geary Street east of Powell Street. Five-minute time limit.

GOLDEN GATE NATIONAL RECREATION AREA COMMERCIAL USE AUTHORIZATION

Commercial Use Authorization is necessary for Presidio of San Francisco, Muir Woods, Cliff House, Lands End, Marin Headlands, Fort Point National Historic Site, Fort Baker, Fort Cronkhite, Fort Funston, Fort Mason and Fort Miley. "Commercial use vehicles" are defined as vehicles over 20 feet in length that visit areas administered by the Park at least one time in any week or four times in any month. Commercial use vehicles must display a window permit when entering the park. Updated insurance will be required. To obtain a Commercial use authorization, contact the Park Business Management Division at 415-561-4742 between 9am and 4pm Monday through Friday.

PARKING

OVERSIZED PARKING – SELF-SERVE

Tour bus parking is no longer available on Pier 30-32 due to structural problems.

OVERSIZED PARKING – NON SELF-SERVE

AT&T Park Motorcoach parking is located on the west side of Terry Francois Boulevard opposite Piers 48/50, alongside AT&T Park Parking Lot A. There is now an on-site machine located towards the North End of the Lot just inside the fence. The rates are \$35 on non-event days. Meter accepts cash and major credit cards, but does not issue change. Drivers may still opt to call the office they prefer to reserve space in advance. The rate for parking that coincides with any event at AT&T Park is a minimum of \$50. No reservations are offered; it is first-come, first-served. SHORT TERM PARKING

AT&T Park Motorcoach parking is located on the west side of Terry Francois Boulevard opposite Piers 48/50, alongside AT&T Park Parking Lot A. During non-event dates Coaches may now pay the meter directly. \$35 flat daily rate applies during non event days. During event days drivers should pay attendant on site. For multiple day reservations and information, call Impark at 415-227-0114, www.impark.com. Also see information under Oversized Parking – Non Self-Serve.

Crissy Field Please note that buses are not allowed west of Mason Street and Crissy Field Avenue. The Crissy Field Overlook, located on Lincoln Avenue, has been completed. There is a short-term bus parking on the east end of the overlook. See additional information regarding Crissy Field restrictions below.

Lombard Street The closest bus parking on the Crookedest Street in the world is located on Jones Street between North Point and Bay Streets. Please do not park in Muni bus zones (\$250 fine).

Fort Mason (Upper) Intermittent construction is scheduled for 2011. Drop off and pick up only. No short term motorcoach parking available.

Fort Point Lot open 7 days/week, but the historic fort is only open Friday-Sunday. Parking for three buses available. For information call Park Dispatcher 415-561-5510.

Golden Gate Bridge Area (San Francisco side of the bridge) The paved parking lot at the south Vista Point area offers minimal coach parking. Additional parking is available in the gravel lot on the north side of Lincoln Boulevard, just east of the Vista Point parking lot. There is a paved trail between the gravel lot and Vista Point.

Golden Gate Park Lot is behind the Music Concourse bandshell. Fee charged. Enter from Concourse Drive, north of Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive.

Point Lobos-Cliff House-Sutro Baths Motorcoach parking, drop-off and drive-through are available at the Merrie Way parking lot above Sutro Baths, east of the Cliff House. There are five, fifty-foot-long spaces reserved for bus parking on a first-come, first-served basis. Buses may drop off passengers at the overlook but must proceed immediately to approved parking area. There is no motorcoach parking in the USS San Francisco lot on El Camino del Mar.

Treasure Island Viewing area just outside Main Gate.

Twin Peaks Large lot available at top of hill. There are restrictions concerning access to Twin Peaks.

RESTRICTIONS

Idling The city restricts motorcoach idling to no more than five minutes unless actively loading and unloading passengers (\$100 fine).

Soliciting is prohibited throughout San Francisco

Double Parking and Bus Zones Please load and unload in a designated space; do not double-park. Tour buses are not allowed to load or unload passengers in Muni bus zones and are subject to a \$250 fine.

RESTRICTED AREAS

Sixth Avenue Between Kirkham Street and Lincoln Way.

15th Avenue Between Lake Street and the Presidio, Richmond District.

18th Street Between Church Street and Upper Market, Castro District.

25th Avenue Between Lake Street and El Camino del Mar/Presidio. Coaches should use Geary Boulevard and Park Presidio Boulevard when traveling from the Cliff House to either the Presidio or the Golden Gate Bridge.

26th Avenue Between Geary Boulevard and California Street

Alamo Square No motorcoach parking. Drive-by only.

Bay Street Between Van Ness Avenue and Larkin Street.

Coit Tower Lombard Street east of Grant Avenue and Telegraph Hill Boulevard.

Crissy Field Motorcoach parking and drop-off are prohibited at the west end of Crissy Field. No motorcoaches are permitted at the new Crissy Field Center located at East Beach. School buses may load and unload by driving through the parking lot adjacent to the Crissy Field Center but must park in one of the following designated bus parking zones :

- Battery East – gravel parking lot.
- Golden Gate Plaza
- Fort Point (Lot open 7 days)

Please use these authorized bus parking zones and avoid making drop-offs at this location.

El Camino del Mar North of Point Lobos Avenue is restricted to school bus parking only. 2 spaces available.

Fort Mason Tour bus access to lower Fort Mason is not legally available at this time. Motorcoach staging, if available, should be coordinated with Fort Mason Center, 415-441-3400.

Golden Gate Park On Sundays and holidays, several streets are closed to vehicular traffic, including John F. Kennedy Drive between Kezar Drive and Transverse Drive. On Saturdays between May and September, John F. Kennedy Drive is closed between Hagiwara Tea Garden Drive (near the de Young Museum) and Transverse Drive. For updates visit www.parks.sfgov.org.

Lincoln Park (Legion of Honor) Access is permitted only from 34th Avenue and Clement Street. Use the same route to exit.

Lombard Street The Crookedest Street in the World is restricted between Larkin and Leavenworth Streets.

Marina District The area bounded by Franklin Street on the east, Chestnut Street on the south, Marina Boulevard on the north, and Baker Street on the west is restricted, including the boundary streets.

Muir Woods Maximum vehicle length is 35 feet. Designated parking in main lot.

North Beach: The area bounded by Stockton Street on the east, Lombard Street on the south, Mason Street on the west, Francisco Street on the north is restricted, including the boundary streets.

Palace of Fine Arts/Exploratorium Roadway conditions and parking conditions around the Palace of Fine Arts will be changing throughout 2011 due to Doyle Drive construction. The parking lot behind the Palace of Fine Arts will be closed beginning Monday, January 17, 2011. Please visit www.presidioparkway.org/traffic_info/drivers_toolbox.aspx for the most up-to-date information.

Pier 39 No drop off or pick up in the red zone on The Embarcadero. Use the turn-out loading area only.

The Presidio The 25th Avenue and 15th Avenue entrances into the Presidio are closed to motorcoaches. Due to ongoing major construction within the Presidio and Doyle Drive, expect road closures and detours throughout the area.

Russian Hill An eight-block area around Russian Hill is restricted. Bypass this area by using Union Street, Pacific Avenue or the Broadway tunnel.

Sea Cliff This residential area between the Presidio and Lincoln Park is restricted.

Telegraph Hill Restaurants on Montgomery Street Motorcoaches should drop passengers at Union and Montgomery Streets.

Twin Peaks Roosevelt Way Coaches should use Twin Peaks Boulevard.

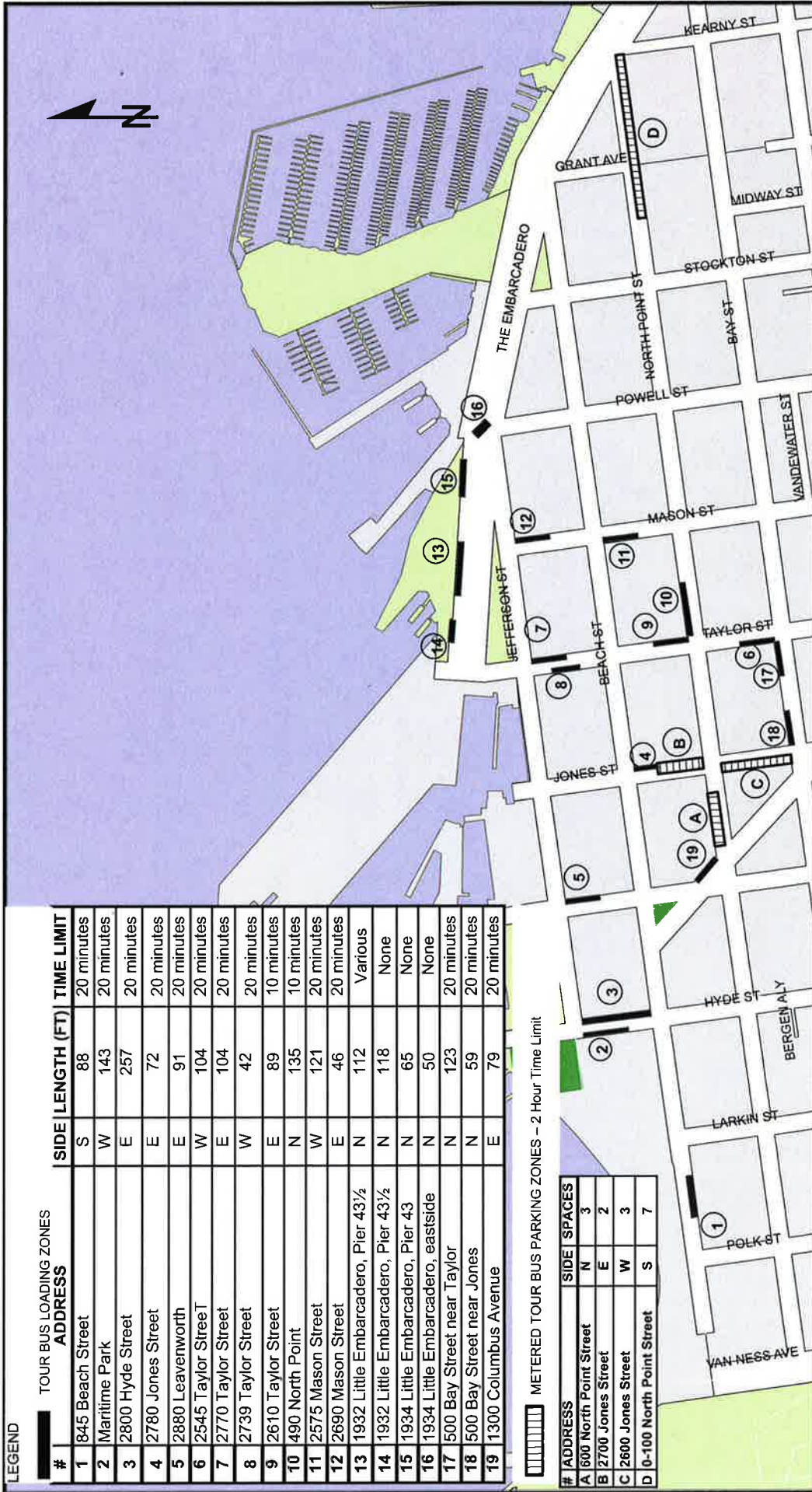
Important Notice - Approach to Golden Gate Bridge

Refer to www.presidioparkway.org for updated traffic and construction information. Through late 2011, Doyle Drive will continue to operate as before, while construction continues on portions of the new presidio Parkway adjacent to the existing highway structures.

The connections between 19th Avenue and the Golden Gate Bridge will remain open throughout construction. However, this corridor is a construction zone with continually changing conditions, so delays may occur. Northbound Park Presidio/Hwy 1 to southbound Doyle Drive will be closed through 2011. Northbound Doyle Drive to southbound Park Presidio/Hwy 1 will be closed through 2014.

The Marin Headlands Improvement project is ongoing. Construction involves temporary road closures and delays on Conzelman Road, Bunker Road and other routes throughout the area that change regularly. Refer to www.projectheadlands.gov for weekly updates on road closures, detours and delays.

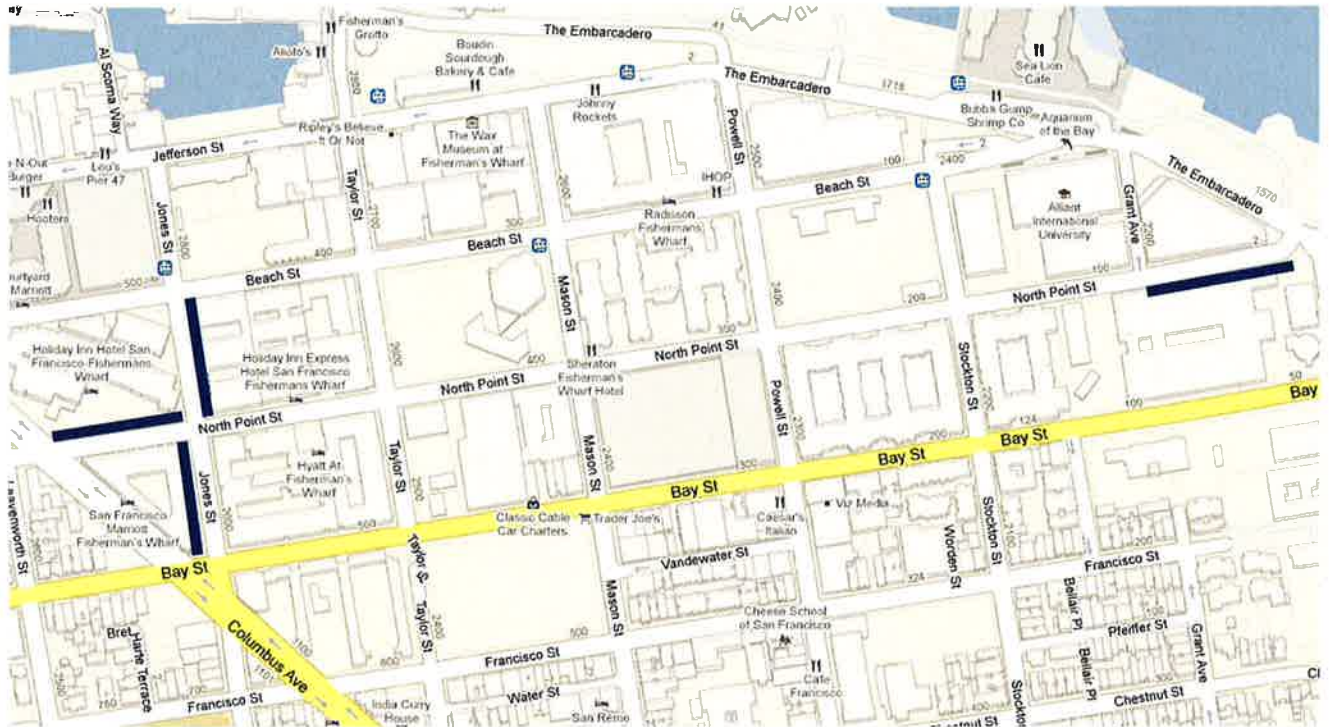

New Tour Bus Short-Term Layover Parking Spaces

There are new metered on-street parking spaces in the Fisherman's Wharf and Pier 39 areas for tour buses (see blue lines on map below). The purpose of these spaces is to give tour buses a place to layover after unloading passengers until passengers are ready to be picked up again.



Summary of the metered tour bus spaces

- Two-hour time limits
- Reserved for tour buses only between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. everyday
- Approximately 60 feet long (to accommodate large tour buses)
- Rate is \$9 per hour (which is the value of three metered 20 foot car parking spaces)
- New parking meters that allow payment by coin, SFMTA Parking Card, or credit/debit card (October 2010)
- SFMTA will review occupancy rates periodically to reassess meter rates; the goal is to charge the lowest price possible at the meter to achieve a minimum standard for availability that is necessary for tour bus drivers to readily find spaces when they are needed.
